AUDITION SCHEDULE:

SUNDAY 1/14/24

Children's 1 and 2 Ages 6–10 10:30 AM - 11:30 AM (Check-in 9:45 AM) ADA Levels 3, 5 and Up; Students from other schools follow age levels

Children's 3 Ages 11 - 13 11:30 AM – 1:00 PM (Check-in 10:45 AM) ADA Levels 7, 9 and Up; Students from other schools follow age levels

Pre-Teen and Pre-Professionals Ages 14 and up 1:30 PM – 4 PM (Check-in 12:45 PM) ADA Levels Intermediate and Advance; Students from other schools follow age levels

- ** Pre-registration for auditions is required online on our website codani.com Auditions
- ** All dancers must arrive 45 minutes ahead of audition time for check-in
- ** All dancers must arrive dressed for ballet class in leotard (shorts for boys with t-shirt), tights, hair up, ballet shoes
- ** Mandatory Parent meetings will be held each day of auditions at the start of each audition group
- ** Some dancers may be asked to return to the next audition group

PRODUCTION INFORMATION:

Production Fees:

The cost of mounting this production is substantial, so to help defray some of the cost, we require a production fee of \$ 295 per dancer (\$395 total for 2 or more immediate family members).

In addition, each family is required to provide 2 checks on the first day of rehearsals as follows:

- \$ 50 cash/ check for cleaning this will be returned once clean-up commitment is completed (one Sunday between Jan 21 and March 10–20 mins to sweep studios with a group of people and empty garbage)
- \$ 200 cash/check for volunteer hours this will be returned once 20 hours of volunteer time is completed

There are many different areas in which to volunteer (including fundraising, driving professional dancers from/to train station, assisting the wardrobe mistress with sewing/alterations, selling ads for Production program, working backstage at the theater, theater security, etc.). We recognize that not every family can commit to the volunteer hours and/or cleaning and accordingly offer the buyout option (the two checks mentioned above).

Participation in this production is an exciting experience for both dancers and their families, and we look forward to a wonderful Spring season!
